Introduction

This is the golden jubilee year of the college. This college is founded in 1967, by the inspiration of Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh and Dalitmitra Pandharinath Patil and with the help of local volunteers. “Tamso ma Jotirgamay” is the motto of this educational institution. Literal *meaning* of “Tamso ma Jotirgamay” is “Lead me from darkness to light”. As per the motto, task of showing light to common people started with the foundation of the college. As per the need of modern times new courses in science faculty are introduced.

For overall development of students, to aspire the students to become best citizens, we implement different co-curricular activities. We constantly take efforts to organize Cultural, Social, Sports and other activities which develop scientific vision. We take support from all the stakeholders.

A) Educational progress

- We got best response from UG, PG and Research students. Merit students prefer to get enrolled in our college.
- Opportunity of employment made available through Skill based program to the students.
- We developed value of social responsibilities through study of human rights and duties.
- Through YCMOU, 1010 students are enrolled and this is the opportunity to a class of society which is left out from education system.
- **Research** : Mr. Vishnu Padwal, Assistant Professor (History) was awarded Ph.D. degree from SGBAU, Amravati.
- A Minor Research Project of Mr. M. A. Pawar has been sanctioned by UGC.

B) Infrastructural Development

- Development work of Samadhi Sthal (Cemetery) of Dalitmitra Pandharinath Patil is in progress.
- Construction of compound wall is in progress.

C) Sports and Physical Education

- Our College has been hosting the tournaments of H-Zone on behalf of SGBAU for the last five years. And constantly was declared winner in the tournament continuously five times.

- Players of the college, participated in, “Shivaji Olympiad” a sports event. In the organization of the sports competition, our College was organizer of district level tournaments. The sports competition was organized in the month of December.

D) Library

- New 746 books were purchased. Total numbers of books with this addition is 38,683 in the central library.
- There are 1489 members of the library.
- Six Thousand e- journals and more than 95000 e-books are made available through N-list.
- Different facilities are provided to readers in the library.
- “Excellent Reader” award given to readers for promotion to develop reading habit.
- A completion *Granth Samiksha Spardha* was organized.
- Exhibition of new books and *Diwali Ank* (A Magazine) was organized.
- Bar code system is used for issuing books.
- Free internet facility is provided to all.

E) National Service Scheme:

One Week Camp from 5 to 12 Jan, 2016 was organized at adopted village Malgani. Activities for cleanliness related to campaign *Swachh Bharat- Sundar Bharat* were organised. Social leaders, Government and Political Representatives and others visited to the camp. Special activities such as Solid Waste Management and Magic pit were organized.

F) National Cadet Corps

- In Annual Camp 21 NCC cadets participated.
- In combined Annual Camp 65 NCC cadets participated.
- *International Yaga Day* and *Kargil Vijay Divas* were celebrated.
- Ten NCC cadets were selected in Indian Army. It is the remarkable achievement.
- NCC students participated in various social activities also.

G) Cultural Activities

Students participated in diverse Cultural Competitions and celebrations. Activities were organized which can help students for their all round development. Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Jayantiutsav, Late Pandharinath Patil Jayanti were the prominent activities. Yuva Mahotsav, Gathering, a special program of famous poet Prof. Dasu Vaidya were organized. Shri Avinash Pawde also guided us.

H) Environment and Nature protection

Various activities of nature and environment protection were conducted in the college. New advance methods applied for conservation of biodiversity. Eco-friendly, nature-friend student groups have been set formed and members of these groups they take initiatives in this regard. NSS and NCC units helped them. Five Hundred One (501) trees were planted in response to the call of forest department of Maharashtra Government. The mother tree is being cultivated for genetic protection.
