Title: Celebration of Bird Week

Objectives:

- 1) To raise awareness about the birds that are captured, brutally treated or produced in captivity for financial gain.
- 2) To educate students about the crucial role of the birds in ecology.

Action Taken:

Bird Week was celebrated by the Department of Zoology at Shri Shivaji College here. Every year November 05 to 12 is celebrated as Bird Week in Maharashtra. On behalf of the Falcon Nature Club of the Department of Zoology, Rangoli Competition and Bird Study were conducted to celebrate this Bird Week. With the support of In-charge Principal Dr. Meena Nikam, college students participated in these activities.

Under this initiative, students of Zoology were watched and observed birds, under the guidance of Dr. Vijayashree Hemke in the green college campus. A total of 39 species of birds were recorded in the college premises. While the students were studied birds along with Somesh Londhe, Chitra Dandde as well as Megha Ingle of Zoology Department.



Observations and study of birds in the campus

Students in small groups scattered in the campus and they observed and captured photographs of birds with Nikon binocular and captured photographs with Nikon Camera. No one disturbed or harm to nest or nestlings.



Indian Gray Hornbill, Shikra, Greater coucal, Black drongo, Alexandrine parakit, Pigeon, Laughing dove, Huppoo, Bulbul, Spotted Owlet and many more bird species were recorded during bird watching in the college premises.

A rangoli competition was also organized on the theme “Birds” for college students. Students drew many beautiful rangolis related to the theme of birds. The Rangoli competition was inaugurated by Dr. Meena Nikam, in-charge principal of the college.
