- Specific charges are being utilized for expenses incurred on the heads earning no provision in the Govt. grants. (eg. sweeping sanitation, electricity, campus garden etc.) and or to meet the expenses exceeding the Govt. ceilings on the head admissible to Govt. grants & disallowed on Pro-Rata Basis.
- The above-mentioned fee schedule is subject to change as per the Government of Maharashtra instructions.
- Eligible EBC and GOI Scholarship holders will get respective concessions/relaxations in their fees but they have to pay the fees not reimbursed by the Government.

Promotion: Promotion from 11th standard to 12th standard will be on the average of the marks scored in four-unit tests, home assignments and two terminal examinations. During the year the promotion rules are set for the purpose. No re-examination for the students who declared unsuccessful. All the promoted student has to fill application form to regularize the admission.

4. H. S. C. VOCATIONAL COURSE 11TH & 12TH

H. S. C. vocational course is differing from the other vocational course taught at Jr. College level. This course has been prepared by National Education Council taking into account the New Education Policy. H. S. C. How to Apply

1. Students desirous of taking admission to the college are required to obtain the prescribed application form along with prospectus.
2. Students must fill in the complete application form carefully, clearly and legibly in his/her own handwriting. Please fill in all details. Incomplete form or form with false information will not be accepted.
3. Signature of the Parent/Guardian on the form is mandatory.
4. The documents must accompany the prescribed form. A check list is given along with application form.

(N.B.-Before submitting the original certificates in the college office, students are advised to take out sufficient number of Photostat copies of their documents for their convenience)

Rules and Instruction for Admission

- The admission in 11th Science /Arts/ Commerce & B. A. I., B. Sc. I, & B. Com. I and M.Com. I, M.A.I & M.Sc. I will be strictly on the merit basis.
- In all the other classes the eligible students will get direct admission.
- The number of students per class is fixed as per the Govt. rules, so the deserved candidates must take admission as early as possible.
- The Govt. & University rules and regulations are strictly followed to decide the number of students, reservation quota, eligibility, admission fees & the documents to be attached.
- Candidates expecting admission in 11th standard must compulsorily attach school leaving certificate, original mark sheet, and true-copies of the both (two copies each) along with the admission form for verification.
- A candidate who passed the qualifying exam from any other Board/University & desirous to seek admission should submit an eligibility certificate.
- Admission will be provisional subject to the approval of the University /Education Department and is liable to be cancelled at any time if the applicant has given false information.
- For university nomination the student of B. A. I, B. Sc. I and B. Com. I and M.Com. I, M.A. I & M. Sc. I must submit the original mark sheet (of all attempts) & true copies (2 copies each) along with the admission form for verification.
- All the regular students of college should confirm their admission within 15 days of declaration of University exam. Result and declared qualified for further education.

Conditions to Seek Concessions / Scholarship

Desirous and eligible students should apply for the respective concession / scholarship in prescribed form along with the necessary document within prescribed time period i.e. generally 31st July of every year.

For renewal of concession / scholarship desirous and eligible students have to submit fresh application form.

In case of refundable fees and other fees, if the fees are not reimbursed from the Govt. the student will have to pay it to the college.

If student resides in a recognized hostel. He/ she should submit the Hostel Warden's Certificate.

- The students migrating from other colleges are required to submit his/her earlier scholarship sanction order number along with his/her application form.
- The income limit for all scholarships is Rs. 1,00,000 for all categories.
- The income certificate of parents should be obtained from the competent authority, as per condition.
- If parents are not alive, students have to produce the relevant death certificate from the competent authority.
- There should not be variation between the caste mentioned in the application form and that mentioned in T.C.
- Students working full-time do not qualify for scholarship.
- Married female student must submit her husband's income certificate for scholarship purpose.
- Only two children from one family qualify for scholarships
- All the scholarship holder students must remain present regularly for lectures/practical/ N.S.S programmes/ N.C.C parade/ Physical education classes.
- Students having attendance less than 75% will not qualify for the scholarship as per G.R.
- Students should refer the notice board from time to time for all the information about scholarships.

- All the students qualifying for scholarship shall have to open an account in the bank mentioned by the college authority

15. CODE OF CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

“Self-discipline is a best form of discipline” observe it.

- Bills, advertisement or notice cannot be displayed in college premises without permission of the Principal.
- "Cleanliness is next to Godness" Cleanliness in the premises at all times must be compulsorily observed. Spitting, littering, Chewing paan/gutka or other intoxicants and smoking is strictly prohibited in college premises. Any infringers will be dealt with severely in accordance with prevailing laws.
- No meetings or programmes should be organized in the college campus without the prior permission of the Principal.
- UG students will have to go for medical check-up by the college appointed medical officer and will have to appear for physical efficiency test.
- Notice will be pasted /pinned on the Notice Board and the students themselves should take note of them. Notice will not be circulated in the class-rooms.
- If the student needs information other than given in the prospectus, he should contact the concerned persons in the college office.
- Students are expected not to walk about or make noise in veranda, corridors or lawns when classes are in progress.
- The principal may impose the following punishments in the interest of the students and Institution Fines, cancelling of attendance, withholding of certificates, suspension and expulsion or rustication.
- Students are expected to have regard and consideration to each other and respectfully to the members to the staff.
- The decisions of the college authority regarding extracurricular activities will be final and binding to each student.
- The students should carefully handle the college books, laboratory equipment, lights, fans etc. They should not, in any way cause damage to the college property. In such case he/she will be punished/ penalized.
- Without permission of the college authority students/staff member must not provide any information related to the college to the media or any other person/office etc.

- Students are eligible to receive ST Bus/Train concessions have to furnish the correct information. Misuse of this concession is a punishable offence.
- Attendance at the Flag Hoisting Ceremony on Independence Day (15th, August) Republic Day (26th January and Maharashtra Day (1st May) is compulsory.
- Laboratory Aprons shall be worn by the students during practical classes.
- Students should not organize their own picnics, excursion trips etc. Without prior permission to the Principal.
- Political movement & violent demonstrations are strictly forbidden in the college campus.

Instruction about Fees and Payment

- Student shall have to pay the fees immediately, as mentioned in the table according to Govt., University & College rules & regulations.
- Refundable fees & other fees not reimbursed by the Govt. will be paid by the students
- Students shall have to pay the full fees of the non-granted courses.
- Students who cancel their admission for any reason shall have to pay full fees and other fees for the whole session. The original documents submitted at the time to admission will not be returned back to students at the time of cancellation of admission. It may take some time.
- If the students are getting advantage of ATKT, in such conditions Govt. Rule about fees (EBC) will be binding on students.
- Student will have to pay all the fees and dues before examination.
- After securing admission in one faculty, if student wants to change the faculty, in such condition he/ she will have to pay admission fee & other fees again.

Instruction for Parents

- The parents should read the rules about student's attendance, fees, code of conduct & discipline carefully.
- Parents should be well aware about their ward's attendance and progress for which they are requested to meet the concerned teacher or Principal for 2-3 times in a year.
- Parents are requested to be remaining present in the programs like 'Parent's Meet and other programs.

19. RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Read the prospectus carefully for proper information.
2. The last date of submission of application forms will be displayed on the notice board of the college.
3. The selected candidates will have to pay all fees within the prescribed date. In case student does not deposit fees by that date, his/her admission will be treated as cancelled.
4. Students who cancel admission at any time for any reason shall have to pay tuition fees & other fees as per university rules.
5. No certificate of any kind will be issued unless full session fees are paid. Any amount paid by the student at the time of admission and later will not be refunded.
6. **All new entrants will have to enrol themselves in the university. A prescribed form for this purpose will be supplied by the college in due course of time or on the date prescribed by the university. Students who fail to fill in the form shall be responsible for any action taken by appropriate authorities.**
7. Students shall have to obey all the instructions of the Principal. They will be answerable to him for their behaviour in general, both inside and outside the college. Students found violating the rules of the college administration or behaving in an indisciplined manner will be expelled from the college. It will be presumed on admission that the students concerned and their parents and/or guardians have read and concurred with these rules.
8. **Students should behave respectfully with all staff members at college and politely with their fellow students, including girls. Any act of disobedience, improper and discourteous exchange of words or indecent remarks, especially at girl students, is a punishable offence and will be viewed seriously.**
9. Students should make careful use of college books, room furniture, fans, laboratory equipment and college property in general. The cost of damage done to it would be recoverable from students either individually or collectively as the case may be.
10. Only special notices shall be read out in the classroom, Students, therefore, should see the notice board daily and keep themselves well informed about the various notices that may be put up there from time to time.
11. No student shall send any information concerning the college for publication either to the press or elsewhere without prior approval of the Principal of college, nor shall he/she approach the president L.M.C. Members except through the college he/she approach the President or the Principal. Any breach of this rule may lead to outright expulsion of the student from the college.
12. The students should not roam in corridors, or play during working hours or free classes. Instead, they should utilize the library and reading room facilities.
