# **Department of Botany Annual Report Academic Session-2105-16**

### I) Organization of Forest Conservation day:

Forest is the Natural resource on our planet. Nowadays deforestation occurs in tremendous amount, so, Forest Conservation Day was organized to create awareness about this. The programme was organized on 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2016. Honorable Principal Dr. N. B. Bhusari Presided over the programme. Prof. Dr. B. R. Patil, Ex. Prof PKV Akola and Prof. Gulabrao Khedekar, Ex Principal Shri Shivaji high school, Chikhli were the chief Guest of the said programme. Prof Dr. B. R. ## IV) 1) Educational Tour:

On 24<sup>th</sup> September Educational tour was organized to observe the Biodiversity. Study tour was organized at Chikhaldara, Distt. Amravati. Chikhaldara is the region which has rich flora and fauna. It is the coolest part of Maharashtra. All types of species from Algae to Angiosperms are found in Chikhaldara. Students observed variety of Lianas, Bamboos, and Bryophytes as well as pteridophytic plants. Forest of chikhaldara is dominated by Tectona grandis (Teak) trees. Student also took the information about medicinal plant used by the Korku tribal. They also visited the points like Panchbol, Gavilgad fort, Bhimkund etc. Fifty students of B. Sc. II and B. Sc. III accompanied by Prof Dr. V. U. Pochhi, Mr. P. A. Theng, Mr. K. B. Theng participated in this Educational tour.

#### 2) Industrial Visit:

Industrial Visit was organized on 26<sup>th</sup> February. Visit was given to Parle Biscuit Factory at Khamgaon where baking, mouldings as well as packing were done on different running machineries. Students of B. Sc. II participated in this visit. Prof. Dr. V. U. Pochhi and Prof. Mahesh Pawar took efforts for this visit.

### 3) Field Visit:

For the students of B. Sc. II, field visit was organized on 12<sup>th</sup> February at village Valti. Field visit was arranged in the farm of Progressive farmer. Mr. Ghanshyam Jagtap. In his field there were polyhouse, Farm pond, Biogas, and Solar Drier Unit, Goat farm as well as honey bees boxes. There was new Annona species called (Balanagar). He extracts the pulp from this and sales in the market. New plant species like "Dragaon fruit" and "All spices" plant are also cultivated in the field. In polyhouse vegetables are cultivated.

One of the Innovative practices made by Mr. Ghanshyam is cultivation of Azolla culture. Azolla culture after drying used as Animal feed. Mr. Ghanshyam Jagtap who is also the Alumni of Botany Department is honured by Government Awards like Prgatishil Shetkari, "Krushisanman" etc. In his farmhouse library is available with the books related to Agriculture.

Students observed all these innovative practices and collected information. Field visit

was arranged in the Guidance of Dr. Vanita Pochhi, Head of department and Mr. Pravin Theng.

All the teaching staff and students also purchased food items like honey, pulp, awala candy kept for sale. Prof. Dr. M. T.
