Workshop on Seed Ball Preparation

Seed ball are an ancient technique for propagating plants from seeds without opening of soil with cultivation tools such as plow.

The preparation of seed ball is a pretty basic. seeds are combined with clay and organic material like compost, well composed manure. The mixture is moisturised and formed into compact lumps or balls, allowed to dry and then cast in field at the appropriate time of year depending on the seed moisture, Climate and rainfall patterns.

Why seed balls

Seed balls can be as effective as a way of establishing plants as plow seedling or drilling and they can be made by anyone anywhere in the world that has access to clay soil and seed.

Seed balls are commonly employed in urban areas where the tillage is simply not an option.

Making the seed balls

Making the Seed ball is relatively simple. The ingredient ratio (in volume) is taken.

5 parts-dry powdered clay

3 parts fine sieved compost

1 part seed

Procedure

First all ingredients combine (clay compost and seed) together in large flat tray thoroughly mix seed of various medicinal plants and wild plants were collected from college campus. All participated student collected seeds and prepare seed ball with the help of above procedure seedball allowed to dry and then cast out in the field.

On the occasion of World Environment Day 2022 in our college Seed Ball Preparation Workshop was organised by department of Botany in Collaboration with Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education. 21 students participated in this workshop, in which students made seed balls for plantation. The main idea behind the Workshop was the vision of Head, Dept. of Botany Dr. V. U. Pochhi to conserve nature. Prof. M. D. Kolte and Prof. D. L. Gavande Guided the students for making the seed ball.


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
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
