## **Article 1**

WHEREAS, **Shri Shivaji Science and Arts College, Chikhli.** (hereafter 'SSSACC') is entering into unanacademic collaboration with **Warsa Ethnic Knowledge Heritage Society Anjangaon Surji** (hereafter 'WARSA') to provide assistance and support to the Graduate and Post Graduate and Research Students of Smt Radhabai Sarda Arts, Commerce & Science College, Anjangaon Surji .

## **Article 2**

WHEREAS, the association between both parties will be focused on Student Centric and Social Activities. It must provide access for students and staff representative/ representatives concerned with the aims and objectives of the WARSA to the programs organized by **Warsa Ethnic Knowledge Heritage Society .**

## **Article 3**

It is binding for both the parties that:

- i. Activities should be in accordance with the objectives of the society **WARSA.**
- ii. Activities should be planned in mutual coordination.
- iii. Students' involvement should be there in every activity.
- iv. Free access should be there for the exhibitions and shows organized by **Warsa Ethnic Knowledge Heritage Society.**
- v. **Shri Shivaji Science and Arts College, Chikhli.** should provide the venue for organizing different events.
- vi. **The expenditure incurred on the event's organization should be borne by collaborating institute / College, with prior discussion and approval.**
- vii. If the activity conducted is income generating , Income - Expenditure statement of the activity organized under this Memorandum of Understanding should be prepared, signed by respective authorities, and shared with the **Warsa Ethnic Knowledge Heritage Society** in a maximum of one month after the activity.
- viii. The resource persons from WARSA should contribute without remuneration.
- ix. Travelling allowance of resource person/ WARSA representative should be born by collaborating institute/ College.

- x. Violation of above terms and conditions will result in termination of collaboration with the permission of WARSA executive body without prior intimation to collaborating institute/ College.

#### **Article 4**

The grantee institution should explore various financial agencies to support the activities mentioned in article 2 from national, international, or private organizations. The financial accounts have to be settled in coordination with both the authorities.

#### **Article 5**

This memorandum of understanding shall be effective from the date of its signing by representatives of both institutions and shall remain in effect for **5 Years**. The termination of this MOU will require notice in six (6) months advance to the other institution



### **Activity and Action Taken Report**



Nature has lots of miracles. It is knitted with different shades of colors and variety of medicinal plants. Plants blossom in the beginning of rainy season. Without sowing seeds different types of wild vegetables grown on mountains and in forest. Wild vegetables are nature's gift for us. In tribal region people eat wild vegetables as their food. These vegetables are good in taste and have their own medicinal values. It has been observed that the traditional knowledge on wild vegetable plants is sharply declining. Unless special efforts are made to educate the younger generation about the importance, the medicinal plants may get lost in near future. The study of the medicinal plant can contribute significantly not only to the developed society but also improve food security in tribal areas as these plants are good sources of required nutrition for health



The collection of wild vegetable plants is the main task of this practice. To collect the medicinal plants and their medicinal value, a wild vegetables competition by the Department of Botany was organized. It was open for all age groups with good knowledge of wild vegetables. As a result 31 students participated in the competition with their recipes of the wild vegetables. The contestants give detail information about the medicinal value of the plants also. After the examination of the plants and their recipes winners were declared. Winner participants were given E- certificates with cash prizes.

To save and spread the traditional knowledge of wild vegetable, this competition was organized on 24<sup>th</sup> Sept 2022. Principal, Dr. O.S.Deshmukh Sir and Dr. V. U. Pochhi IQAC Coordinator and HOD, Botany guided for this activity.

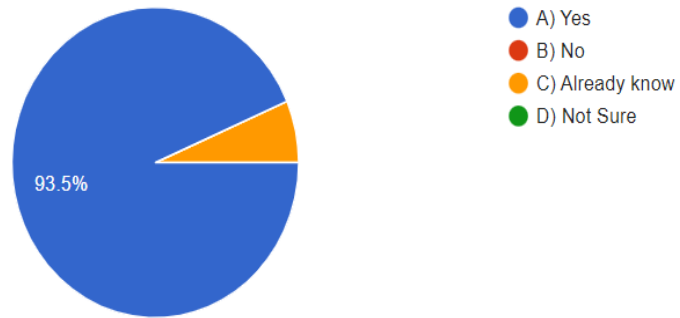

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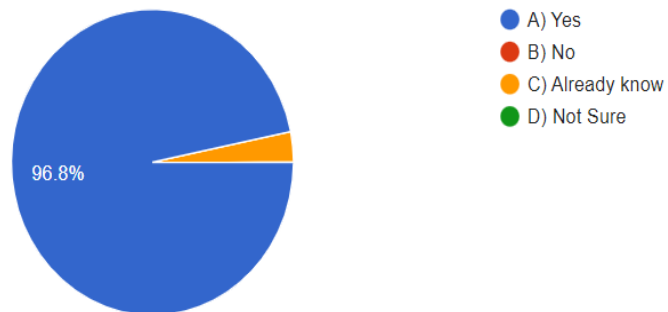

Do you know the nutritional values and health benefits of wild edible vegetables?

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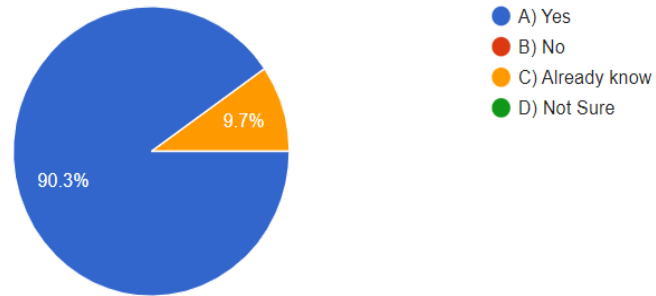

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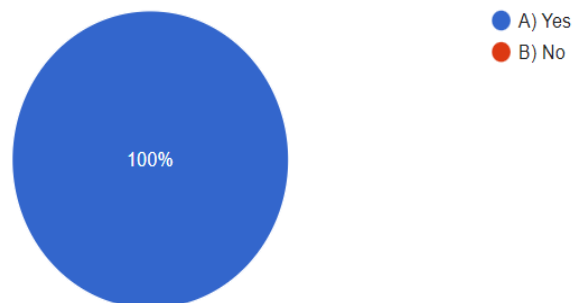

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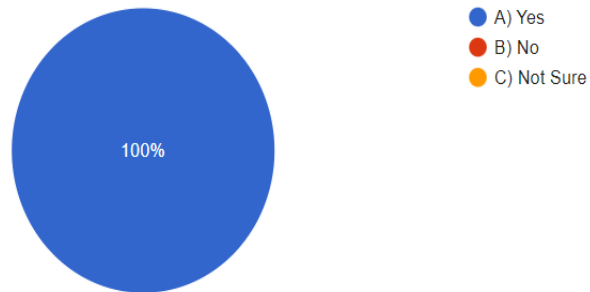

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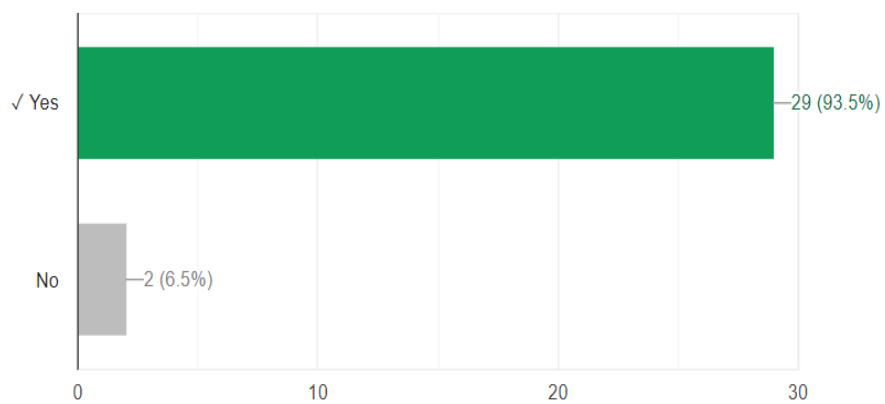
