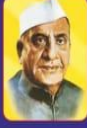

History and Heritage

Over the years, the college has established a commendable tradition of initiative and innovation, growing into an institution of significant stature in the educational landscape. Its diverse academic activities, imbued with a strong value system, focus on balancing knowledge acquisition with skill development. The institution has successfully instilled confidence in society regarding the quality of education it imparts.

The college was established in **1967** to meet the ever-growing educational needs of society under the banner of the **Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati**. Visionary leaders such as **Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh** and **Dalitmitra Pandharinath Patil** played a pivotal role in its foundation. Eminent personalities, including **Adv. R. D. Bhonde ‘Sarkar’** and **Dalitmitra Santoshrao Patil**, along with other socio-political leaders, extended significant support in establishing this institution. The local farming community also contributed generously to this noble endeavour.

The students of this institution, through exemplary discipline and active participation in academic, co-curricular, and extracurricular activities, along with the dedicated support of their teachers, have contributed immensely to building the institution’s reputation in academic and other fields.

The institution has consistently followed a policy of self-renewal and adaptation to changing educational scenarios. It began with the introduction of the **Science faculty at the undergraduate level in 1967**, followed by the **Humanities (Arts) faculty in 1971**, and **Commerce & Management in 1989**. Postgraduate programs were introduced with **M. Com. in 2009** and **PG programs in Science and Arts in 2010**. An **English-medium UG Commerce program** was launched in 2011. Research programs such as **M.Phil. and Ph.D.** in Science, Arts, and Commerce have also been initiated. The **YCMOU Study Centre** was established in 2012.

The college has achieved several accolades and recognitions for its academic excellence, research innovation, and social outreach. Some of the notable achievements are:

Additionally, soft skill development courses are conducted to ensure the holistic development of students.

With a continuous vision for growth, the institution has been further strengthened under the leadership of **Hon’ble Shri Harshvardhan P. Deshmukh** and other executive members of the society. Since its inception in 1967, the college has been committed to continuous improvement, expansion, and excellence.

 3. Migration Certificate (if from a Board/University other than Maharashtra State Board or S.G.B. Amravati University).
 4. Caste certificate, Validity and Non-Creamy Layer.
 5. Aadhar Card.

Preparation of Merit List for Admission:

A provisional merit list will be prepared in descending order of merit for each subject and displayed on the notice boards of the respective departments/college website.

Candidates whose names appear in the merit list will be required to attend an interview on dates as per the programme to be displayed by the concerned department on the notice board/college website.

No separate intimation will be sent to the students' home addresses.

Reservation Criteria:

Admission shall be carried out strictly as per the Government reservation policy.

Any applicant belonging to the backward category will be required to submit the original caste certificate, the validity certificate, and the non-creamy layer certificate, all issued by the competent authority at the time of admission.

Other Instructions:

- At the time of admission, the applicant must produce the original leaving certificate/Transfer certificate of the institute last attended. Duplicate TC will not be entertained.
- If any of the statements made in the application form or any information supplied by the applicant in connection with his/her admission is found to be false/incorrect, his/her admission will be cancelled, and the fees forfeited.
- Students coming from other universities must submit a Migration Certificate, duly signed by the Registrar of their previous university, on or before **15th September**, along with the prescribed migration (immigration) fee.
- For study tours and educational visits, students will have to pay the educational tour expenses separately.
- A student migrating from another university must produce his/her degree certificate as per University notification.
- A student admitted to the Department shall have to attend at least 75 % classes as per the requirements of S. G. B. Amravati University Ordinance.
- Information regarding examination, etc. can be found in the ordinance book, syllabus & University gazette published from time to time.
- Students found indulging in any activity contrary to the rules of discipline are liable to be expelled from the department without any notice.

Compulsory Uniform:

Wearing the prescribed uniform is mandatory for all students (both boys and girls).

1.9 Admission Procedure:

- Applicants are advised to keep themselves informed of various notices displayed from time to time.
- Admissions are subject to the eligibility norms of the **S.G.B. Amravati University, Amravati** or **Maharashtra Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education** or **DTE**.

- At the time of admission, students must bring a printout of the submitted application form along with attested copies and original documents for verification.
 - i. School/College Leaving Certificate (T.C.)
 - ii. Statement of marks of the last examination passed/failed.
 - iii. Migration Certificate (for students from Boards other than Maharashtra State Board or Universities other than S.G.B. Amravati University).
 - iv. Caste certificate, Validity and Non-Creamy Layer.
 - v. Aadhar Card
- Students who pass the qualifying examination from any other University and desire to seek admission should submit an eligibility certificate.
- Applicants who have a break in education should submit a **gap certificate** in the form of court affidavit stating the reason for the gap.
- Applicants will be required to surrender the original copy of their School/College leaving certificate at the time of finalisation of admission.
- Duplicate T. C. will not be entertained.
- Admission will be provisional, subject to the approval of the University and is liable to be cancelled at any time if the applicant has given false information, or I=University enrolment is not given to him/her.
- Reservation of seats for candidates belonging to backward classes will be as per Government rules. If a candidate fails to claim or provide valid proof, the benefit of reservation will not be granted.
- All matters related to admission will be handled by the admission committee. Applicants are required to contact this committee during working hours as displayed on the Notice Board.
- All the B. Sc. I and II students of this College of session 2025-26 are provisionally admitted to the next higher class subject to declaration of results.
