Student Feedback on curricula 2015-16

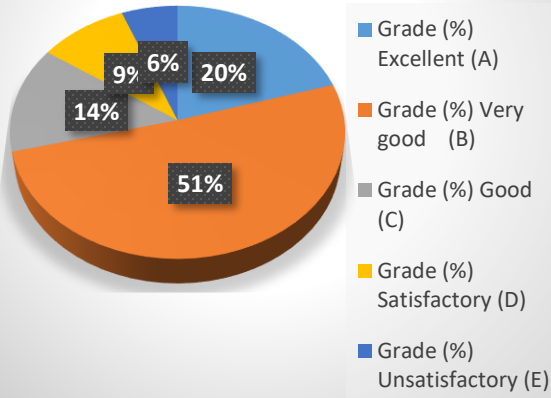

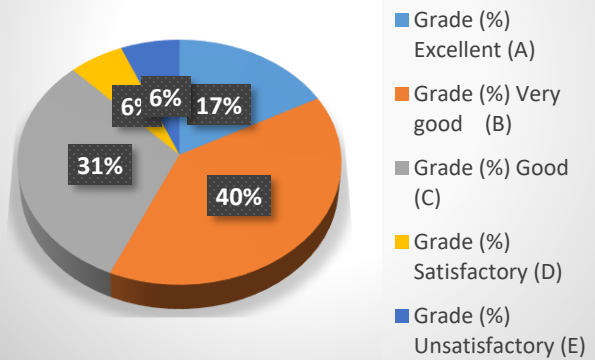

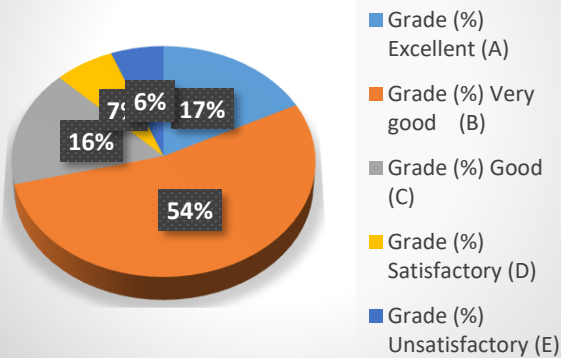

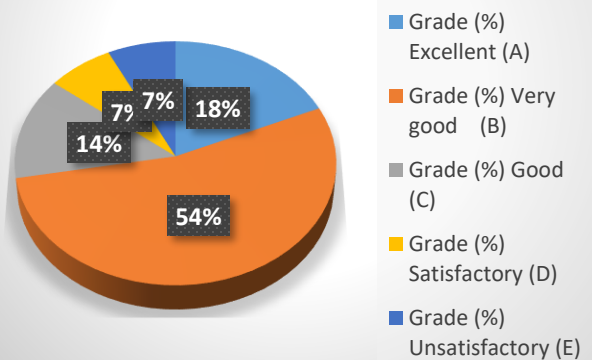

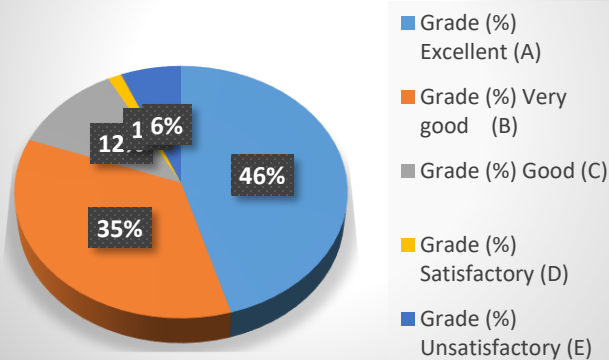
