Mentor offer them emotional, spiritual and academic support along with motivation. The teachers of the institution take up the responsibility of safeguarding and nuturing the newly admitted students. The mentor act as buffer for the first year students and help them to get adjusted to our college environment.

Duties and responsibilities of Mentor.

- The mentor shall meet the mentees regularly and record the outcome of meeting in the their copy .
- The details about each mentee will be recorded and periodically updated.
- The mentor shall identify the students performing exceptionally well in curricular or co-curricular activities and should report to

the head of institution or department for providing further motivation to advanced/gifted learners.

- The mentor shall also identify the students whose performance/attendance is below average, guide students and also arrange for remedial teaching if required.
- The mentor shall interact with the students and try to find out the cause of the problem or an indifferent behaviour. If required the mentor will involve the parents, head of the department or counsellor for reforming the students.
- The mentor shall be a member in the disciplinary committee, if a student (mentee) violates the code of conduct.

Duties and responsibilities of Mentee.

- Fill the correct personal information in the form at the time of joining the mentor-mentee scheme.
- Provide details of attendance, academic assesment record, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities record to the mentor whenever asked for.
