Activity:

The University Level Intercollegiate Seminar Competition for B.Sc. Students was organized by the Department of Physics, Shri Shivaji Science and Arts College, Chikhli, in collaboration with the Amravati University Physics Teachers' Association (AUPTA) on 5th February 2026 at the Department of Physics. The activity aimed to develop presentation skills, subject knowledge, and confidence among students. The competition was conducted under the guidance of Dr. P. R. Padole (Principal). The program was convened by Dr. V. B. Huse (Head, Department of Physics) and coordinated by Dr. P. P. Padghan, with the support of the organizing committee members Dr. P. B. Nalle, Dr. D. N. Bhoyar, Prof. S. L. Salwant, and Prof. S. D. Landkar. The notice of the competition was circulated through WhatsApp to ensure wide participation from various colleges.

The seminar topics were "Transistors and Operational Amplifiers" (B.Sc.-II, Semester IV) and "X-rays and Raman Effect" (B.Sc.-III, Semester VI). The event was graced by distinguished academicians including Dr. A. U. Bajpayee (President, AUPTA), Dr. M. R. Belkhedkar, Dr. S. P. Hargunani and Dr. V. S. Kalyamwar as judges. The program was conducted as per schedule, including registration, inauguration, seminar sessions, and valedictory function. The evaluation was carried out based on presentation skills, subject accuracy, PPT

preparation, question-answer session, and time management. Students actively participated with great enthusiasm and presented their topics effectively.

Feedback: Feedback was collected from Google forms.

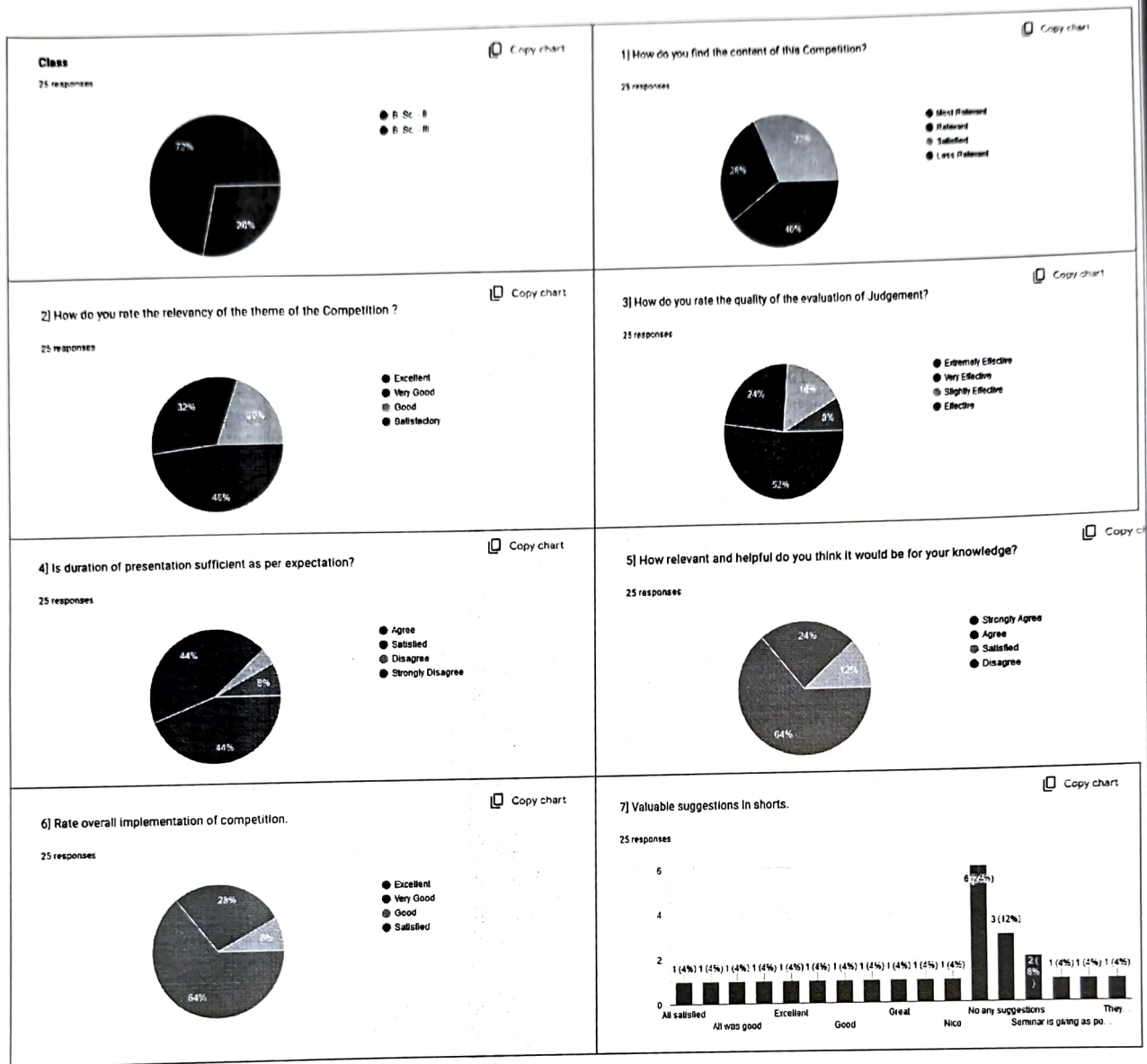
