1. As a teacher, I suggest that the B.Sc. 2024–2025 curriculum should be designed as a dynamic, learner-centric ecosystem that balances core scientific rigor with real-world application.
2. The design must strictly adhere to the Curriculum and Credit Framework (CCFUP), ensuring that at least 50% of credits are dedicated to the Major to maintain academic depth, while the remaining credits are used for Minors and Open Electives that encourage cross-disciplinary "out-of-the-box" thinking—such as a Physics student minoring in Economics.
3. We must transition from rote-heavy syllabi to Learning Outcomes-based Curriculum Frameworks (LOCF), integrating mandatory vocational training and internships to bridge the employability gap.
4. Crucially, for the four-year Honours with Research track, the curriculum should introduce research methodology early to foster scientific inquiry.
5. From a pedagogical standpoint, I recommend embedding AI-driven tools, virtual simulations, and the Indian Knowledge System (IKS) into daily teaching to make science both globally competitive and culturally rooted, ultimately shifting the teacher's role from a lecturer to a facilitator of critical thinking and problem-solving.
