At the Zoology Department of the Sri Shivaji College here, workshop on the training of e-Bird App concluded with enthusiasm under the chairmanship of the Principal Dr. Pramod Padole. For the workshop, Trainer was Mr. Saurabh Kakde-Naturalist. The workshop was organized under a MoU between the Department of Zoology of Sri Shivaji College and Wildlife & Environment Conservation Society, a nature conservation organization in Amravati.

e-Bird App is an App that is used globally and in this, experts studying birds, students, amateur bird watchers record the number and habits of bird species in their respective areas, through which it is possible to study different birds around the world from one place.

Workshop trainer Mr. Saurabh Kakde gave a detailed guidance to the students about e-Bird App in the first session and in the second session of the workshop, he demonstrated how to record the birds in the college premises on the e-Bird App. The Principal of the college who is constantly trying to make the students of his college techno-savy, Dr. Pramod Padole, while speaking from the chair, appealed to the students to share their records with e-Bird App as many types of birds are found in Chikhli area. Head of Department Dr. Vijayshree Hemke said that while studying Zoology, modern technology should be added to it, so the topic of the workshop was e-Bird App.

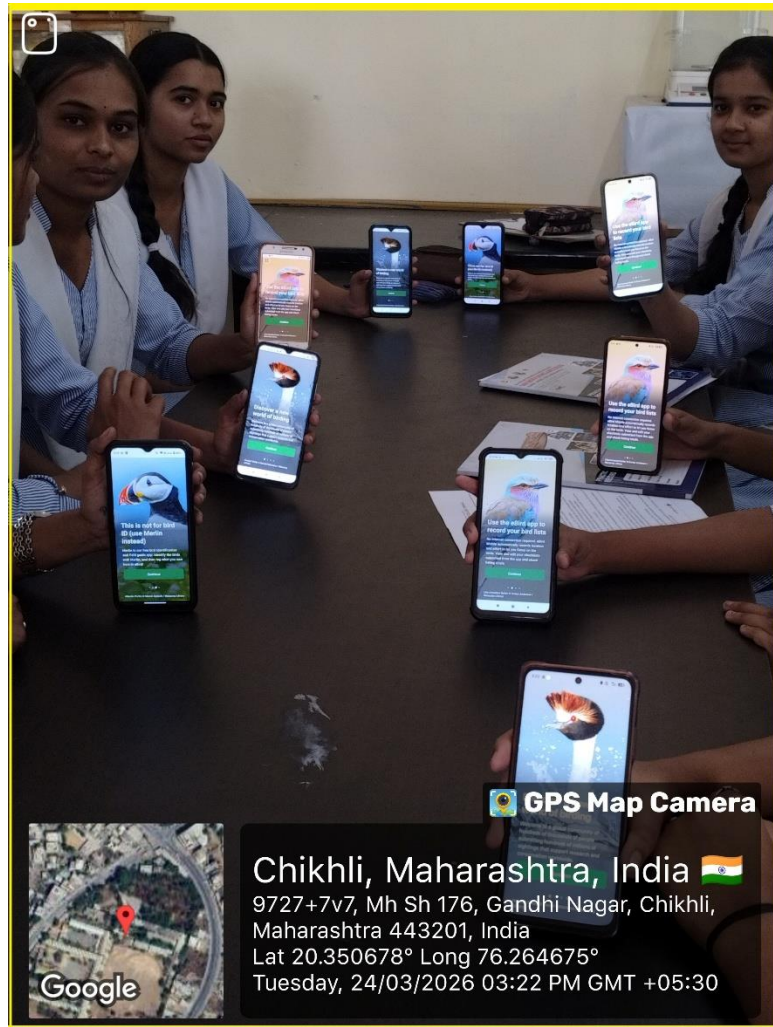
