Study Tour at Koradi (31.08.2024)

The educational visit was organized in accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding between the Department of Zoology, Shri Shivaji Science and Arts College, Chikhli, and the Department of Fish Seedling Center, Koradi, under the Government of Maharashtra on **August 31, 2024**.

A total of **24** students from the third year of the Bachelor of Science program participated in this excursion. During the visit, the students explored various types of fish ponds, including nursery ponds, hatchery units, and fish seedling areas, while also gaining insights into the artificial breeding processes of fish. Additionally, they studied several fish species, such as Catla, Rohu, and Cyprinus.
